

RING SIZE GUIDE

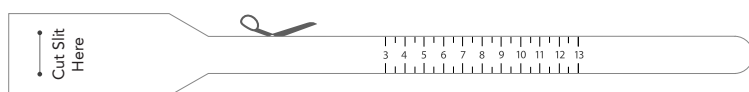
METHOD ONE

Prior to printing this page, ensure that page scaling is set to "none" on your print dialog box.

- Measure the guide below with a ruler to confirm the printed size is accurate.

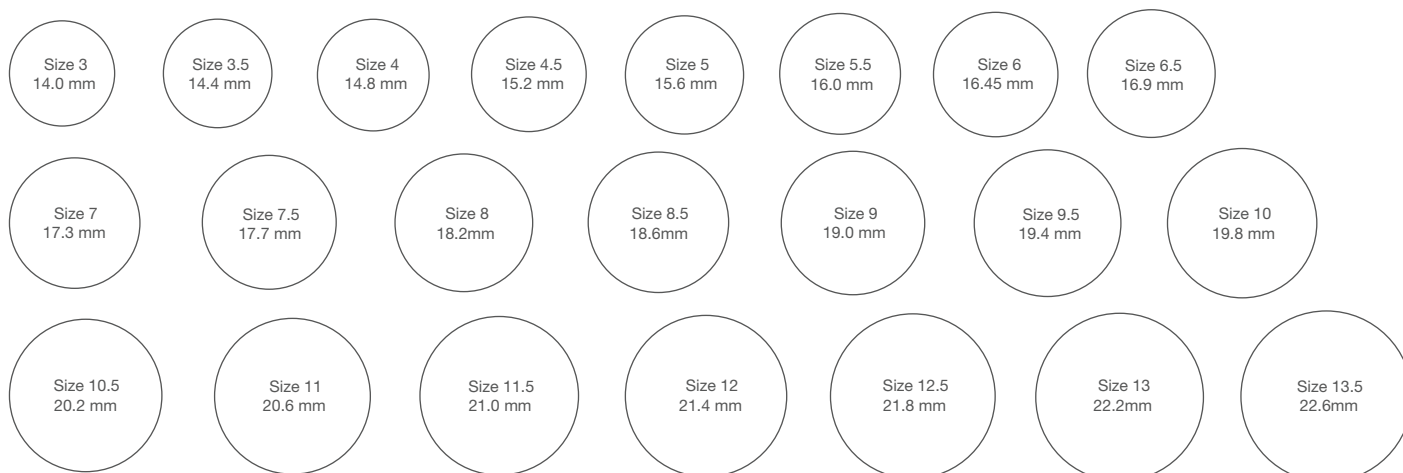


- Cut out the sizer below.
- Place around finger, pull tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to be accurate.
- Don't measure cold fingers.
- For the most accurate reading measure finger at the end of the day when it is largest.



METHOD TWO

- Choose one of your partners rings that correctly fits the appropriate finger, Engagement and wedding rings are traditionally worn on the ring finger on the left hand.
- Next place the chosen ring on the chart below and match the inside of the ring with the correct circle below, if you find that the ring falls somewhere between the 2 sizes it is always best to opt for the larger size.





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Compare your measurement with this chart to determine your ring size.
